Hook: Long shank, size 8-12

Thread: Yellow

Tail: Red deer hair under yellow wool.

Body: Yellow wool.

Rib: Fiery red hackle clipped.

Wing: Brown turkey feather.

Legs 6 to 8 Pheasant tail fibres, knotted.

Collar: Olive deer hair.

Head: Olive deer hair, spun and clipped.
