<p>February 2020</p> <p>DAPPLED DOG The Complete Guide to New Zealand Trout Lures. (P 29 & 116)</p> <p>HOOK: 4 - 8 TAIL: grey barred squirrel tail BODY: fluorescent chenille (lime green, red, or orange) HACKLE: grizzle cock hackles HEAD: black</p>	
<p>March 2020</p> <p>BLUE CHARM An Introduction to Fly Tying (P 96)</p> <p>HOOK: 4 – 12 up eye salmon TAG: oval silver TAIL: golden pheasant crest and black ostrich as a butt BODY: black floss with oval silver rib HACKLE: blue cock WING: bronze mallard with teal over wing and golden pheasant crest as a topping</p>

<p>GEEHI BEETLE Australia's Beast Trout Flies (P31 & 32)</p> <p>HOOK: mustard 94840 # 12 - 18 THREAD: black TAIL: golden pheasant tippets BODY: peacock herl palmered with ginger cock hackle RIB: fine gold wire, wound counter to the body HACKLE: as for palmer, but preferably a shade darker.</p>	 <p><i>Geehi Beetle</i></p>

<p>GOLDEN TOM JONES Australian Fly Patterns (P 143)</p> <p>HOOK: kamasan B175, size 10 – 14 THREAD: black TAIL: olive rabbit BODY: gold tinsel WING: olive rabbit</p>

<p>RED SPINNER Australian Fly Patterns (P 131)</p> <p>HOOK: kamasan B401, size 12 – 14 THREAD: black TAIL: good quality paint brush fibres tied trident BODY: orange seal's fur and rabbit blend, lightly dubbed RIB: fine silver wire THORAX: lightly dubbed black fur HACKLE: red cock hackles</p>

<p>CADDIS GRUB Australian Fly Patterns (P 18)</p> <p>HOOK: tiemco 2457, size 10 – 12 THREAD: black BODY: lightly dubbed colour to suit naturals RIB: swannundaze fine, colour to suit naturals THORAX: black rabbit picked out WINGCASE: black synthetic raffia HEAD: black tying thread</p>	 <p><i>Tied by David Dodd</i></p>

<p>DICK'S SINGLE WOUNDERWING SPINNER Fur and Feather (P 92 - 94)</p> <p>HOOK: 14 partridge up eye THREAD: black TAIL: black cock hackles vanished BODY: same hackle feather as tail WING: single hackle feather halved, and prepared as wonderwing and vanished HACKLE: black cock hackle, clipped inderneath</p>

<p>LITTLE PINE DUN Australia's Best Trout Flies (P 59 & 60)</p> <p>HOOK: mustard special limerick 9578B # 10 - 12 THREAD: uni-thread 8/0 dark green TAIL: furnace brown fibres BODY: green silk WING: blackbird wing HACKLE: Hoffman furnace brown</p>	 <p style="text-align: right;"><i>Little Pine Dun</i></p>
October 2020	
<p>TASMAN MINNOW Australian Fly Patterns (P 247)</p> <p>HOOK: mustard 34044, 34007, tiemco 811S, black magic salt water fly, size 2-2/0 THREAD: black flat waxed nylon BODY: silver mylar COLLAR: polar bear polybear (or hivis, widows web, neer hair) TOPPING: two strans each of silver and pearl krystal flash then widows web (or substitute) CHEEKS: three or four strands of silver sparkleflash, mylar motions or polarflash EYES: pearl 2 mm self-adhesive eyes, epoxy over</p>	 <p style="text-align: right;"><i>Tied by Chris Beech</i></p>

<p>ULTRA SHRIMP Australian Fly Patterns (P 219)</p> <p>HOOK: mustard 34007, size 8-2/0 THREAD: flat waxed nylon ANTENNA: black krystal flash TAIL: light brown or tan neer hair with a flash of orange BODY: tan, dun or grey synthetic dubbing LEGS: grizzle hackle, palmered EYES: 15 kg mono burnt and painted black SHELLBACK: streamer hair, epoxy with devcon WEIGHT: small dumbbell eyes SUPPORTS: 7 kg mono</p>	 <p style="text-align: right;"><i>Tied by Paul Williamson</i></p>
