### Show us your fly: May

#### CLIPPED HACKLE HUMPHY

Australia's Best Trout Flies (P 43 & 44)

**HOOK:** kamasan B400, # 10 – 16

**THREAD:** black

**TAIL:** Moose body hair

**BODY:** Orange dyed hackle, wound on & clipped to shape

**BACK:** Deer hair for the hump is tied in first & returned over the clipped body hackle being tied down behind the wing

**WING:** White Hi-Vis wing material

**HACKLE:** Grizzly

Tie in the following order for best results: tail, wing, deer hair for hump (tie in from the tips); body hackle; front hackle.
