Australian Fly Patterns (P 155)

HOOK: Wet fly, size 10 – 16

THREAD: black

TAIL: Golden pheasant tippets

BODY: Claret seal's fur

RIB: Fine gold wire

WING: Bronze mallard

THROAT: Furnace cock hackle fibres
