


<p><b>NOEL'S NOBBY</b>          (Australia's Best Trout Flies Page 75 &amp; 77)</p> <p><b>HOOK:</b> Kamasan B800 # 14  <b>TREAD:</b> Pearsall's Silk, Black  <b>WING:</b> Yellow Chenille  <b>LEGS:</b> Bunch of golden pheasant tippets  <b>HEAD:</b> Natural elk hair spun and clipped to leave legs and bulky head</p>	 <p style="text-align: right;"><i>Noel's Nobby</i></p>

<p><b>BLOODY MARY</b>          Australia's Best Trout Flies (P 95 &amp; 97)</p> <p><b>HOOK:</b> Kamasan B175, # 8-10  <b>THREAD:</b> Uni-thread 6/0 black  <b>TAIL:</b> Antron, red  <b>BODY:</b> Red Lurex  <b>RIB:</b> Gold Wire  <b>HACKLE:</b> Black cock (poor quality)</p>	 <p style="text-align: right;"><i>Bloody Mary</i></p>

<p><b>ORANGE (KOSCIUSZKO) SPINNER</b>          An Introduction to Fly Tying (P 93)</p> <p><b>HOOK:</b> Mustard 94842, # 10-12 – 10 Longshank  <b>THREAD:</b> Orange  <b>TAIL:</b> Medium brown hackle fibres  <b>BODY:</b> Orange synthetic raffia  <b>RIB:</b> fine gold wire  <b>HACKLE:</b> Medium brown hackle</p>	 <p style="text-align: right;"><i>Orange (Kosciuszko) Spinner</i></p>

<p><b>WESTERN LAKES NYMPH</b>          The World's Best Trout Flies (P 137 &amp; 139)</p> <p><b>HOOK:</b> Tiemco TMC 200R (S/E, 3XL, slightly curved shank)  <b>THREAD:</b> black  <b>TAIL:</b> Furnace hackle fibres  <b>BODY:</b> Brown seal's fur or substitute  <b>RIB:</b> Embossed silver tinsel  <b>THORAX:</b> Generously dubbed hare's fur</p>	

## SHOW US YOUR FLY LIST FOR 2022

June 2022

### RED GILL

The World's Best Trout Flies (P 47 & 50)

Apply head cement to the shank and wrap with lead wire over the middle three-quarters.

**HOOK:** Kamasan B175, size 10

**THREAD:** Fluorescent green single-strand floss

**UNDERBODY:** Wound lead wire

**TAIL:** Light ginger hackle fibres

**RIB:** Dark copper wire

**ABDOMEN:** Green Floss

**GILLS:** A short length of bright red wool protruding by about 1/16 inch each side of the rear of the wingcase

**THORAX:** Blend of yellow fur mixed with clear Antron, well picked out

**WINGCASE:** Light grey Antron with 3 strands of pearl Krystal Flash for highlight

### EN BETTE SWOT

The World's Best Trout Flies (P 54 & 55)

**HOOK:** Partridge L3A (D/E, wide gape) size 12 - 26

**THREAD:** black

**TAIL:** Golden pheasant tippetts

**BODY:** Black seal's fur or substitute with a pronounced thorax

**RIB:** Fine gold wire

**HACKLE:** Black cock hackle with a cream cock wound in front. The concave side of the hackles should face each other and should occupy about a third of the shank

### SURF CANDY DARK BACK

Australian Fly Patterns (Page 200)

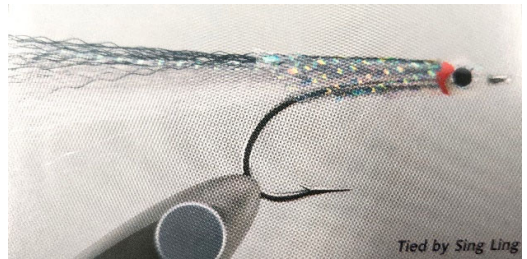
**HOOK:** Mustard 34007, size 4 - 4/0

**THREAD:** White Danville's flat waxed nylon

**BODY:** Super Hair or Streamer Hair with a few strands of Krystal Flash, dark blue on grey on white

**EYES:** Prism tape eyes

**RED GILLS:** Nail polish or model paint

September 2022

### **BERCHDOLT'S HOPPER**

Australian Fly Patterns (Page 58)

**HOOK:** Dry Fly, size 8-16

**TREAD:** Black

**TAIL:** Golden pheasant tippets

**BODY:** Green floss

**RIB:** Yellow floss

**WING:** Pheasant breast feather

**HACKLE:** Orange cock and golden pheasant tippets



October 2022

### **OCTOBER DUN**

Australian Fly Patterns (Page 46)

**HOOK:** Dry Fly, size 12-14

**TREAD:** Black

**TAIL:** Mallard duck fibres

**BODY:** Red seal's fur and rabbit in mixed colours

**WING:** Matched pair of mallard duck quills

**HACKLE:** Light brown cock hackle



November 2022

### **PERCH FRY**

Australian Fly Patterns (P 183)

**HOOK:** Kamasan B200, size 4 - 10

**THREAD:** Black 8/0

**BODY:** Mixture of maroon and black seal's fur dubbing

**TAIL:** Natural squirrel tail

**BODY:** Pink wool in 3 sections

**REAR HACKLE:** Red cock

**MID HACKLE:** Yellow Cock

**FRONT HACKLE:** Tan grizzle cock, swept back to form head

**HEAD AND EYE:** Lacquered, with yellow and black, painted eye



December 2022

### **PARACHUTE ADAMS**

Australian Fly Patterns (P 37)

**HOOK:** Dry Fly, size 10-16

**TREAD:** White

**TAIL:** Brown and grizzle cock hackle fibres

**BODY:** Muskrat underfur

**WING:** Calf body hair

**HACKLE:** Grizzle and brown cock hackle, interwound
