



<p>June 2023</p> <p>TASMAN MINNOW Australian Fly Patterns (P 247)</p> <p>HOOK: Mustard 34044, 34007, Tiemco 811S, Black Magic salt water fly, size 2-2/0 THREAD: Black Flat waxed nylon BODY: Silver Mylar COLLAR: Polar Bear PolyBear (or Hivis, Widows Web, Neer hair) TOPPING: Two strands each of silver and pearl Krystal Flash then Widows Web (or substitute) CHEEKS: Three or four strands of silver sparckleflash, Mylar Motion or Polarflash EYES: Pearl 2 mm self adhesive eyes, epoxy over</p>	 <p style="text-align: right; font-size: small;"><i>Tied by Chris Beech</i></p>
<p>July 2023</p> <p>GOLDBEAD HARE'S EAR SHAGGY The World's Best Trout Flies (P 17 & 18)</p> <p>HOOK: Tiemco TMC 3761 size 10-12 THREAD: Brown BEAD: Gold bead, 4 mm for size 10, 3 mm for size 12 TAIL: Bunch of Rabbit-fox hair BODY: Hare's ear fur, also woven between the hackle and the bead RIB: Fine gold round tinsel LEGS: Mottled hen hackle</p>	 <p style="font-size: small;">3</p>
<p>August 2023</p> <p>ELK HAIR CADDIS The World's Best Trout Flies (P 23)</p> <p>HOOK: Partidge E1A or L3A size 6-24 THREAD: To match body colour BODY: Tying thread colour to match the insect HACKLE: Palmered cock, to match the insect, with the upper fibres trimmed WING: Trude-style, elk or deer body hair HEAD: Clipped ends of elk/deer hair</p>	 <p style="font-size: small;">4</p>

<p>ORANGE ASHER Fish Flies Volume One (P 150, Plate 1)</p> <p>HOOK: AC80000BR, TMC 100 or DAI1180, size 12-16 TREAD: Black TAIL: Grizzly hackle barbs RIBBING: Flat gold tinsel BODY: Orange floss HACKLE: Grizzly tied in by the tip and tied palmer style over the body</p>	
October 2023	
<p>BLUE DUN Fish Flies Volume One (P 169, Plate 12)</p> <p>HOOK: TMC3769 or DAI1550, sizes 10-16 TREAD: Gray TAIL: Blue Dun hackle barbs BODY: Dubbed with muskrat fur HACKLE: Blue Dun tied on as collar and tied back and down WING: Natural gray duck quill sections tied on edge over body</p>	
November 2023	
<p>TELLICO Fish Flies Volume One (P 230, Plate 7)</p> <p>HOOK: TMC3761 or DAI1560, sizes 10-16 THREAD: Black TAIL: Guinea fowl barbs RIBBING: Peacock herl SHELLBACK: Ringneck pheasant tail section BODY: Dubbed with #6 yellow lamb's wool LEGS: Brown hen hackle tied on as collar and tied back</p>	
December 2023	
<p>Catskill Fish Flies Volume One (P 171, Plate 4)</p> <p>HOOK: TMC3769 or DAI1550, sizes 10-16 TREAD: Cream TAIL: Dyed imitation barred lemon woodduck barbs BODY: Brown floss HACKLE: Brown tied palmer style over the body WING: Dyed imitation barred lemon woodduck barbs tied over the body</p>
