TAIL: Sandy dun cock fibres

Monaro Caddis

HOOK: Tiamco 101, # 14-16

TREAD: 8/0, Grey

HACKLE: Red cock

BODY: Dubbed flue from brown partridge feather

WING: Bunch of brown partridge feathers, laid flat

Eyes: Burnt monofilament
