**TREAD:** Black

**TAIL:** Brown hackle fibres

**UNDERBODY:** Copper wire (optional)

**BODY:** Dubbed brown seal's fur

**RIB:** Fine copper wire

**THORAX:** Peacock herl

**HACKLE:** Brown cock hackle

**HEAD:** Black thread

## **WATER RAT SMELT**

Australian Fly Patterns, Page 127

**HOOK:** Tiemco 5262, sizes 6 - 12

**TREAD:** Black

**TAIL:** Olive cock hackle fibres and teal feather fibres

**BODY:** Water rat underfur substitute

**RIB:** Fine silver wire

**THROAT:** Mixture olive, orange, and teal feather fibres

**CHEEKS:** Pearl tinsel

**HEAD:** Black tying thread

## **CADDIS GRUB BEAD HEAD**

Australian Fly Patterns, Page 18

**HOOK:** Tiemco 2457, sizes 10 - 12

**THREAD:** Black

**BODY:** Lightly dubbed, colour to suit naturals

**RIB:** Swannundaze fine, colour to suit natural

**THORAX:** Same as body or peacock herl

**HEAD:** Medium gold bead

## **CALF WING ROYAL COACHMAN**

Australia's Best Trout Flies, Page 91 & 92

**HOOK:** Mustard 80000BR, # 14 - 16

**TREAD:** Uni-Thread 8/0 black for body and white for wings

**TAIL:** Golden pheasant tippets

**BODY:** butt and shoulder, peacock herl; middle, red floss silk

**WING:** White calf tail or body hair

**HACKLE:** Natural red cock
