**HOOK:** Mustard 34007, Size 8 – 1/0

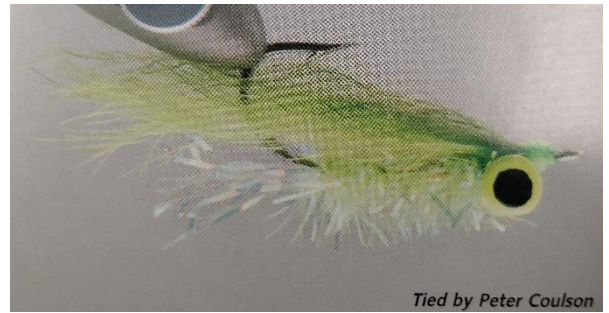
**TREAD:** Chartreuse flat waxed

**WING:** Dark oval over chartreuse Slinky Fibre

**EYES:** Powder-coated chartreuse dumbbell eyes

**HOOK:** # 10 - 2

**TREAD:** Black or yellow.

**TAIL:** Red or orange cock fibres.

**BODY:** Yellow Chenille.

**RIB:** Oval silver tinsel.

**HACKLE:** Honey grizzle (Light cree)

**WING:** Honey grizzle cock hackles tied matuka

**STYLE:** Jungle cock cheek optional

### **SHERRY SPINNER**

Fly Patterns an International Guide Page 17

**HOOK:** 14

**THREAD:** Light brown

**TAIL:** Honey dune cock hackle fibres.

**BODY:** Sherry-coloured floss, or a mixture of seal's fur to give sherry colour.

**RIB:** Fine gold wire

**HACKLE:** Honey dun

**WING:** Optional: two blue dun hackle points tied spent.

**HOOK:** Size 6 – 12

**THREAD:** Black

**TAIL:** None

**BODY:** Black chenille.

**RIB:** Oval silver tinsel.





**HACKLE:** Guinea fowl hackle fibres.

**WING:** Tied matuka style with four black cock hackles, with bronze mallard over.

<p>August 2026</p> <p><b>BLACK DOUGLAS</b> Australian Best Trout Flies, Pages 31 &amp; 33</p> <p><b>HOOK:</b> Down-eye, wide gape, # 12  <b>THREAD:</b> Black gossamer  <b>TAIL:</b> Pheasant tippets, a generous bunch  <b>BODY BUTT:</b> (first third of hook from bend)  Hackle dyed rich yellow, clipped to half length of main body hackle  <b>MAIN BODY:</b> Black hackle, clipped – length equal to the gape  <b>HACKLE:</b> Cock-y-bonddu (one size large i.e. a variant)</p>	 <p><i>Black Douglas</i></p>

### HIGHLAND DUN

Australian Best Trout Flies, Pages 75 & 77

**HOOK:** Kamasan B401, size 10 - 12

**TREAD:** Pearsall's silk, brown

**TAIL:** Bunch of brown hackle fibres

**BODY:** Brown tying silk palmered with brown hackle

**RIB:** Fine copper wire

**WING:** Brown speckled hen wing, slips tied concave side inward, forming a single backward-sloping wing

**HACKLE:** Brown cock with two turns of badger hackle in front.

### MATCHAM'S ROSELLA

Australian Best Trout Flies, Pages 99 & 101

**HOOK:** Mustard 80000BR, # 6-8

**TREAD:** Black monocord

**UNDERBODY:** Fine lead wire

**BODY:** Yellow mohair wool to halfway point; then red mohair wool in front

**WING:** Strip of black fur extending back half hook length

**RIB:** Copper wire

**EYES:** Jungle cock

**TOPPING:** Four strands of peacock herl

**THROAT:** Small blue fur throat

### LEE'S GURGULER

Australian Fly Patterns, Page 222

**HOOK:** Mustard 34007, sizes 2/0-1

**THREAD:** Pink flat waxed

**UNDERTAIL:** Sparkleflash silver

**OVERTAIL:** White bucktail

**BODY:** Large pearl Krystal Flash

**OVERBODY:** Yellow Evazote

**THROAT:** Red Krystal Flash

### CLEAR WATER SHRIMP

Australian Fly Patterns, Page 212

**HOOK:** Mustard 34007, sizes 4

**TREAD:** White flat waxed

**UNDERBODY:** Spackleflash chenille UV pearl

**BODY:** Slinky Fibre, white

**ANTENNA:** Pearl Krystal Flash

**EYES:** Black Mono eyes

**FINISH:** Two coats of clear epoxy on the back and head with a sprinkle of fine black glitter between coats
