HOOK: 14

THREAD: Light brown

TAIL: Honey dune cock hackle fibres.

BODY: Sherry-coloured floss, or a mixture of seal's fur to give sherry colour.

RIB: Fine gold wire

HACKLE: Honey dun

WING: Optional: two blue dun hackle points tied spent.
